# Coronavirus - measures in Saxony-Anhalt (valid from March 17th, 2020 momentarily until April 19th, 2020)

#### **Gatherings**

Crowds of more than 50 people are prohibited.

If there are fewer than 50 people, a distance of at least 2m must be guaranteed. The organizer must record the contact details of all participants. (Name Address)

Gatherings include meetings in associations, churches, mosques, synagogues and other religious communities.

#### Restaurants / events

Restaurants may only open under strict conditions. See "gatherings": No more than 50 people, 2m distance and recording the contact details of the guests

#### Closed

Clubs, discotheques, taverns/pubs, trade fairs, exhibitions, theaters, cinemas, concert halls, museums, community houses, youth centers, libraries, zoos, saunas, canteens of the universities, swimming pools and sports facilities (in closed rooms and outdoors). Fairs and festivals are canceled. Children's playgrounds may no longer be used.

### Open

Retail businesses for food and animal feed, weekly markets, delivery services, pharmacies, medical supply stores, drugstores, petrol stations, banks and savings banks, post offices, laundromats and wholesale facilities. Courts, public prosecutors, authorities, as well as offices or institutions that perform public service tasks do not close. That also applies to book and magazine retailers, hearing care professional and opticians. Service providers and craftsmen can also pursue their work further.

## **Hospitals / care facilities**

There is a general ban on visitors for the university clinics in Halle and Magdeburg.

Otherwise applies: one visitor per day for one hour in hospitals, rehabilitation facilities, nursing homes, facilities for people with disabilities.

Excluded are visitors that:

- suffer from respiratory infections
- have had contact in the last 14 days with people who are suffering from corona
- have resided in a risk area identified by the RKI in the past 14 days
